As Great Science Share for Schools celebrates the fact that The University of Manchester is 200 years old, we are raising the profile of science by shouting about what we think is important.

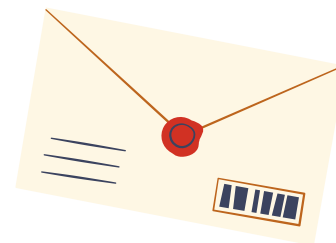
The aim is to make a noise about why asking-investigating and sharing science is important to all our futures.

Our target is a minimum of 200 letters!

What do we ask of you?

Pupils are asked to write a letter, in the style and level that suits them. The letter should include the following.

- **What do you like about learning science?**
- **What's been your favourite science enquiry you've done in school?**
- **What kinds of things do you want to do more of in science?**
- **Why is science important to everyone in our school and world?**



Each pupil should include one wish: **I wish that...**

Perhaps they wish they could do more science, or do more practical enquiries, or learn science outdoors, or perhaps meet more scientists etc. **What would they wish for?**

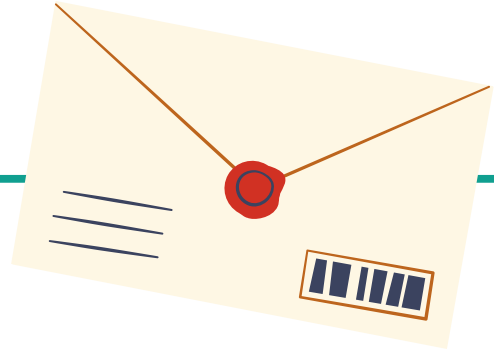
